# What do we need and why?



## Teams

- Sailors can see their success
- Presentation of the club
- Attract sponsors

## Skippers (ISAF ID required!)

- Grouping at events

# Criteria

- ▶ Results of all 2K – events
- ▶ For a certain period
- ▶ Based on the quality of the events
- ▶ Considering the gender rule



Our approach:

Using the existing Match Racing Ranking System as a base

# Results of all 2K – Events



Organizers are asked to provide the results:

Place	Team Name	Skippers	ISAF ID	Gender rule	Points

# The Ranking is based on results of a certain period



- ▶ It takes some time to climb the ranking but
- ▶ A team will not drop out while not joining all events
  
- ▶ Results of the last 24 months will be included in the ranking
  - Factor = 6 for the last 12 months
  - Factor = 3 for the previous 12 months
  
- ▶ A limited number of events will be included in the ranking:
  - for 2012: maximum of 2 Events
  - for 2013: maximum of 3 Events
  - from 2014 on: maximum of 4 events per year

# Grading of Events



- ▶ Grade 1 = Leading International Events
- ▶ Grade 2 = Top International Events
- ▶ Grade 3 = Int. Events and National Championships
- ▶ Grade 4 = National Events
- ▶ Grade 5 = All other (local) events

# Gender Rule



The Standard Notice of Race states:

*A team shall comprise [insert number] persons, a maximum of [insert number] persons of a single gender per team, who shall sail together in two boats, [insert number] to a boat with a maximum of [insert number] of a single gender per boat.*

⇒ **The agreed target is a 50 : 50 split per team!**

- ▶ IOC and ISAF are supporting this gender rule
- ▶ From 1.1.2014 on teams will receive a 15% bonus for gender split of 50 : 50.



# Calculation



- ▶ A team finishes first in Monaco 2014:
  - First place = 100 points
  - Gender = factor 1,15
  - Top Int. Event = factor 2,5
  - Current year = factor 6
- ▶ Calculation:  
 $100 \text{ points} * 1,15 * 2,5 * 6 = 1.725 \text{ points}$   
for the team and for each of the skippers
