



## 2K LOCAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### **1. APPLICABLE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1.1 The Sailing Instructions for this event, as required by RRS 90.2, are constituted by these Local Sailing Instructions in conjunction with the 2K Standard Sailing Instructions which can be found on the website of the 2K Team Racing International Association (<http://2kteamracing.com/>).

### **2. RACE OFFICE**

- 2.1 The race office is located at Club Nautico Scarlino, inside Marina di Scarlino, in the Control Tower.
- 2.2 The race office will be open:
- (a) For registration between 15.00 of April 21 and 18:00 of April 21
  - (b) Daily between 09:00 and 18:00
- 2.3 The official notice board is located at Club Nautico Scarlino main entrance.
- 2.4 Signals made ashore will be displayed from a flagpole located just behind Club Nautico Scarlino.

### **3. AMENDMENTS TO THE STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

### **4. BOATS AND SAILS**

- 4.1 The event will be sailed in Beneteau 7.5\_type boats.
- 4.2 Boats will be identified by hull numbers.
- 4.3 Boats will be equipped with the items as detailed in Addendum G

### **5. CREW MEMBERS, NUMBER and SAFETY**

- 5.1 The total number of crew for one team, including the skippers, shall be 4.
- 5.2 The maximum of any one gender shall be 50% of total, plus one.

### **6. EVENT PROGRAMME, EVENT FORMAT AND STARTING SCHEDULES**

- 6.1 A list of eligible teams and the starting schedules are detailed in LSI Addendum E
- 6.2 The event programme and event format are detailed in LSI Addendum F.
- 6.3 The racing days are scheduled as on April 22 to 24.
- 6.4 The intended time of the first warning signal each day is 11:00.
- 6.5 The latest time for a warning signal on the last day of racing will be 15:00.

### **7. RACING AREA and COURSE**

- 7.1 The racing area will be right in front Marina di Scarlino.
- 7.2 The courses as specified in the SSI will be used.
- 7.3 Description of Marks
  - (a) The RC boat will be identified by an orange flag.
  - (b) The starting/finishing line mark will be a yellow cylindrical thin mark.
  - (c) Marks 1, 2 and 3 will be yellow cylindrical marks.

### **8. PRIZES**

- 8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 teams.

##### F2.1 Stage One:

A Knockout series shall be sailed between the first and second ranked teams from Stage One. The winner of Stage Two shall be the first team to score two race wins, the other team shall be ranked second.
